Brioche Pasquier's roots began in 1936 at Les Cerqueux, France when Gabriel Pasquier opened a small village bakery. In 1974, the family business became into 'Brioche Pasquier Ltd', which now employs more than 3,000 people across Europe.

As part of the international development of the group, the company opened an office in Milton Keynes 10 years ago with just three staff, which has now grown to 30.

In early 2014 the company began the construction of a production site in Wymbush that will service the UK market.

Brioche Pasquier still use authentic processes and original recipes to create its range of products which are sold in most of the UK's major food retailers.

The company's objective is to adapt to the British market whilst holding onto their French traditions, enabling the company to be closer to its customers and distributors.
